


### THE FOREST VIEW ACADEMY

Staged Intervention Overview to Managing Academy Attendance





#### STAGE 4

Statutory intervention to promote and protect children's welfare

Where a child is identified as being at risk of, or has experienced harm, a referral will be made to Children's Social Care/Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub (MASH).

Action at this stage supersedes any ongoing intervention at any previous stage and applies to all levels of pupil attendance.

## The Forest View Academy Stage 1 Intervention



A pupil's attendance falls below the school attendance target of 96%

Are there unresolved 'N' codes due to absence

### **YES**

- School letter N sent to parent
- 2. N codes changed to 'O if no explanation given

NO

## Reason given and improved attendance

No further action - monitor

No reasons given OR reasons given are unsatisfactory OR attendance fails to improve within 2 weeks

### Letter 2

- Sent from C&FSW if no improvement and/or no satisfactory explanation has been received to explain the absences
- 2. Attendance check after 15 days

### **Ongoing Procedures**

### **First Day Absence Contact**

Telephone contact made with parent/carer on the first day of a child's absence from the academy (safeguarding duty)

#### **Lates**

Letter L sent after 3 sessions of lateness after registers have closed (U mark)

### **Improved**

No further action

### **No Improvement**

School meeting with C&FSW & Parent

#### Letter 1

- 1. Sent from C&FSW to parents of pupils whose attendance drops below school's attendance target of 96%
- 2. Attendance check after a minimum of 15 days

Academy letter sent if patterns of illness and/or medical absence exist

Is absence due to illness/medical reasons?

No further action - monitor

### **Letter 3**

- 1. Sent from C&FSW
- 2. Meeting arranged with parent
- 3. Attendance check after 15 days

### No improvement

Concerns still exist and no/insufficient medical evidence received

## Improved or valid reason given

No further action - monitor

### **No Improvement**

Is attendance below 90% over a six week period?

### No – Letter 4

- 1. Sent from Head of Academy
- 2. Repeat meeting arranged with parent
- 3. Attendance check after a minimum of 15 days

### <u>Improved</u>

No further action - monitor

# The Forest View Academy Stage 2 Intervention



A pupil's attendance falls between 80% and 90% over a ¶ week period

### **Attendance Panel Meeting**

- Establish everyone with parental responsibility and date of birth, other siblings and their schools
- Consider using the Early Help Unit
- Set up a 15 day review period
- If parents fails to attend Did not attend letter sent

### **Enforcement Letter 1**

Sent from Head of Academy to parents

### **Initial review**

Carried out 2 weeks following Enforcement Letter 1

### **Improved**

De-escalate to stage 1 and monitor

### **No Improvement**

FPN referral
